

HL7 Object Identifier (OID)

HL7 maintains an [OID Registry](#) of globally unique ISO ([International Organization for Standardization](#)) identifiers. We have officially registered an OID in order to serve as an authority for OIDs within this namespace.

2.16.840.1.113883.3.7194.2	OpenMRS Patient identifier	<pre><id root="2.16.840.1.113883.3.7194.2" extension="1234-4" /></pre> <p>Where "1234-4" is a patient identifier within an OpenMRS implementation.</p> <p>Note that we do not define separate OIDs for every identifier type. If needed, the identifier type could be specified within the extension.</p>
2.16.840.1.113883.3.7194.3	OpenMRS User identifier	<pre><id root="2.16.840.1.113883.3.7194.3" extension="1234-4" /></pre> <p>Where "1234-4" is a user's identifier (e.g., system ID) within an OpenMRS implementation.</p> <p>Note that we do not define separate OIDs for every identifier type. If needed, the identifier type could be specified within the extension.</p>
2.16.840.1.113883.3.7194.4	OpenMRS Provider identifier	<pre><id root="2.16.840.1.113883.3.7194.4" extension="1234-4" /></pre> <p>Where "1234-4" is a provider's identifier within an OpenMRS implementation.</p> <p>Note that we do not define separate OIDs for every identifier type. If needed, the identifier type could be specified within the extension.</p>
